



TAAI WITH FIJI TOURISM IN INDIA



Tourism Council Chairman Mr. Jay Bhatia along with WR office bearers Mr. Sampat Damani, Col., Shashidharan -VSM, AFV & Mr. Sameer Karnani. Met the Fiji Tourism Minister Mr. Kota in mumbai On 4 Feb. Discussing promotion of bilateral tourism between Fiji and India TAAI stressed the need for more workshop and educational workshops for its members. Mr. Bhatia has also extended an invitation to the Minister, Mr. Koya to attend the India Travel congress and the 62 convention in Bali. The minister along with Mr. Pranav Kapadia, representative for Fiji tourism in India assured support to TAAI and will jointly work in promoting tourism. During the Mumbai stop of the Tourism's Fiji Roadshow, the Minister for Industry, Trade and Tourism, Faiyaz Siddig Koya, launched a travel brochure on Fiji that specifically targets Indian travellers. The brochure was developed through a partnership between Tourism Fiji and Kuoni SOTC, which is a well-known, Swiss-based luxury travel and tour operator, with branches in several countries, including India. "Fiji has managed to capitalise

on its long standing business relations with Kuoni SOTC in the UK and European markets and we see the launch of this brochure as the beginning of an even more successful partnership in India and the Asian region," Mr Koya said. "Kuoni has gained a wealth of experience working in the Indian market for 60 years This will assist Fiji in understanding the needs of Indian travellers and enable us to package our products accordingly." Also in Mumbai, the Minister had a series of meetings with prominent travel agents, including a meeting with senior representatives from the Travel Agents Association of India (TAAI). "The meetings with travel agents and especially TAAI have been fruitful and I am confident as a result we will see further increases in Indian visitor numbers in the coming year," the Minister said. TAAI has extended an invitation to the Minister to attend the Indian Travel Agent Forum in March 2015. The Mumbai roadshow was attended by 130 travel and tourism operators. The Roadshow ended last Friday in the city of Chennai.

COUNTRY HAS SEEN 421% JUMP IN TOURIST ARRIVAL AFTER NEW VISA SCHEME: RAJNATH SINGH PTI Feb 17, 2015.

NEW DELHI: India has seen 421.6 per cent jump in tourist arrival after implementation of a faster visa clearance process, Home Minister Rajnath Singh. Addressing a meeting of the consultative committee of Members of Parliament attached to the Home Ministry, Singh said after the launch of the Visa Enabled by Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA) and Immigration, Visa, Foreigners Registration and Tracking (IVFRT) project, 65,000 visas have been issued in 75 days and on an average 1,000 travel documents are being issued per day at present. There had been 421.6 per cent jump in tourist arrival during December 2014 as compared to the previous year," he told the Mps. In December 2013, a total of 2,700 tourist visas- on-arrival (VOAs) were issued while in December 2014, the corresponding number had gone upto over 14,000. ETA and IVFRT enable the prospective visitor to apply for an Indian Visa from his or her home country online without visiting the Indian Mission and also pay the visa fee online.

Once approved, the applicant will receive an email authorising him or her to travel to India and the person can travel carrying a print out of this authorisation. On arrival, the visitor has to present the authorisation to the immigration authorities who would then stamp the entry into the country. The Home Minister told the members that the IVFRT is one of the Mission Mode Project (MMP) undertaken by the Home Ministry under the National e-Governance Plan (NeGP). The scope of the project covers 178 Indian missions abroad and 13 Foreigners Regional Registration Offices (FRROs), 674 Foreigners Registration Offices (FROs) and 83 Immigration Check Posts (ICPs) within the country. Singh said as on date the project has been implemented in 155 Indian missions abroad and 13 FRROs, 450 FROs and 81 ICPs covering 85 per cent of the foreigners coming to India. The implementation of the project in remaining 23 Indian missions abroad, biometrics software installation in 116 Indian missions abroad, 224 FROs and implementation of e-gates at airports will be completed by March, 2017.
